WIP Sections

The first 17 WIP Sections were established September 2007 to signify regions of the world where WIP's FIPP membership is strongest: Africa, Australia, Benelux, Canada, Central-Eastern Europe, Iberian, India-Iran-Pakistan, Israel, Korea-Japan-China, Latin America, Mediterranean, Middle East, North America, Puerto Rico-Caribbean, SE Asia, Switzerland, Turkey, and UK & Éire. In 2010, four new Sections were recognized: Canada, Colombia, Hungary, and Iran. Sections renamed in 2010 were: India and USA. In 2011, Italy qualified for Section. In 2013, Brazil and Malaysia were awarded Section status. In 2015, Ireland was recognized as a Section. In 2017, South Korea earned Section status, bringing the total Sections to 26.
